

Dear runner

Thank you for supporting the race. A reminder that we will have a collection point for Wrexham Foodbank at Race HQ. Please click on the link for a list of items they need at [WREXHAM FOODBANK](#).

Here are the brief, key points you will need to enjoy the event. If you are unable to attend you can transfer your entry to another runner using the 'transfer entry' button on [this link](#). This facility will close at midnight on Friday 7th February. Please ensure that you get the number from the person you had a transfer with. If they did not take up that option, then collect your number on the day. We are unable to offer deferrals or refunds.

Race - The race will start at 09:30am. Please join the start line at an area suitable to your ability or please join in with one of our pacing groups.

Parking - There are two main parking areas. The first is the space around Redwither Tower Redwither Road LL13 9XT. This is close to the startline. The second is the overspill car park at HMP Berwyn Bridge Road LL13 9QE and surrounding roads. This is a 10 minute walk to the start line. There will be signs. Race numbers - These are being posted to those who requested it. This facility is now no longer available so please collect on the day from Race HQ close to Redwither Tower. This will be signposted from the parking areas. There will be portable toilets here as well at the finish area, 3 miles and 7 miles.

Race HQ & Course - This has been scaled down and will be (sheltered) outdoors for collection of unposted race numbers and last minute information. The start line is situated at the same place on Bridge Road North.

The finish area is on Oak Road Wrexham Industrial Estate LL13 9RG outside the former 'BICC/Pirelli Clubhouse'. Details of the course can be seen below. There will be water around 2.7 miles, 6.5 miles, 10 miles and at the finish.

Until we have a large-scale permanent home for Race HQ we are unfortunately unable to have a baggage facility.

Finish Line - When you cross the finish line you can collect your water, medal and delicious Welsh cakes or Sourdough crumpets courtesy of our sponsors Village Bakery. A reminder that the race has a 2 hour and thirty minutes cut off time, on-course services will not be available to anyone taking longer than this and you will not appear in the results or be able to collect your medal etc.

Prizes - There will be a small prize ceremony for the top three men and women at the finish area around 11:30am (depending on the weather). Listen out for announcements.

Finally - We have a great team of marshals, volunteers and community groups attending. Please be kind and patient with everyone you meet on the day.
